

No Zap Fly Traps

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NZ 1500 Wall Sconce Model



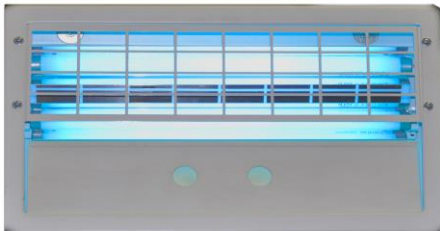
- Dimensions: 6"H X 17"W X 6"D
- Weight: 4 pounds
- Provides effective coverage for 1000 square foot area.

NZ 2000 Wall Sconce Model



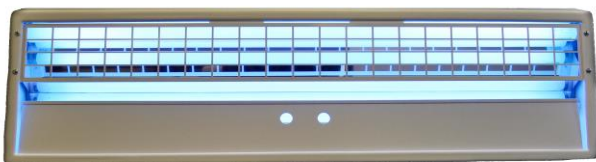
- Dimensions: 5"H X 23½"W X 4½"D
- Weight: 7 pounds
- Provides effective coverage for 1000 square foot area.

NZ 3000 Fly Trap



- Dimensions: 13"H X 20"W X 7"D
- Weight: 14 pounds
- Provides effective coverage for 1500 square foot area.

NZ 5000 Fly Trap



- Dimensions: 14"H X 49"W X 7"D
- Weight: 32 pounds
- Provides effective coverage for 2500 square foot area.

How it Works:

- With light bulbs turned on, flying insects in the vicinity are attracted to the No Zap Fly Trap unit.
- Flying insects fly to the light but get stuck to our sticky glue pads.
- Once the flying insects are stuck to the glue pads, they cannot escape.
- Sticky glue pads are lethal to flies and other insects, but completely safe for humans and pets. No insecticides or toxic chemicals are used.
- Flies and other flying insects are completely contained in the No Zap Fly Trap unit until the sticky pad is replaced.
- Replace sticky pads every 30 days, or as needed to keep No Zap Fly Trap warding off flying insects at maximum efficiency.

Things to Consider:

- No Zap Fly Traps work by attracting flying insects to the unit, so keep that in mind when you're selecting a spot to install it in.
- The NZ 1500 and NZ 2000 wall sconce models are wall mounted. They can conveniently be installed "hiding in plain sight" to customers views while preventing customers from seeing what is trapped inside.
- We recommend setting up the larger No Zap Fly Trap units (NZ 3000 and NZ 5000) in an area away from food prep spaces, and where flying insects can view the alluring light without obstruction.

Energy Consumption:

- Our green technology engineering allows the No Zap Fly Trap to operate using the same amount of energy as a standard fluorescent fixture.
